

Town of Forest Special Board Meeting Minutes

I Call to Order: The Town of Forest Board Meeting was called to order at 8AM on Tuesday May 26th by Chairman Mark Davison.

II We began our meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

III Attendance: Those present, Mark Davison, Denise Valentine, Bill Schiller, Todd Teed, Bob McCoy, Dianne Johnson

IV Affirmation of Proper Public Notice - Notice was confirmed.

V Public Input: There was none.

VI Discussion and Possible Action on Applying for” Safe Streets for All Grant”.

Todd has been working on the requirements for applying for the Safe Streets for All Grant. The Grant would pay 80% if project were to be selected. The grant is geared towards safety at intersections and bike lanes but not limited to that. Todd would like to write the grant to request to replace our 2006 truck with snowplow at an estimated cost of 309K, with our portion estimated at 62K. The reasoning is that plowed roads are safest for the community and for Fire and EMS to reach their destinations in the event of a fire or accident.

Motion by Bob McCoy, seconded by Bill Schiller that we apply for the “Safe Streets for All Grant.” Motion carried.

VII Discussion and Possible Action on Data Centers. There was a general discussion on the pros and cons of the legality of the ordinance that was suggested by Grant County. It was suggested that we investigate a lawyer who may be knowledgeable in Township rights, and laws so that if we present an ordinance regarding Data Centers it has a likelihood of holding up. No action was taken.
